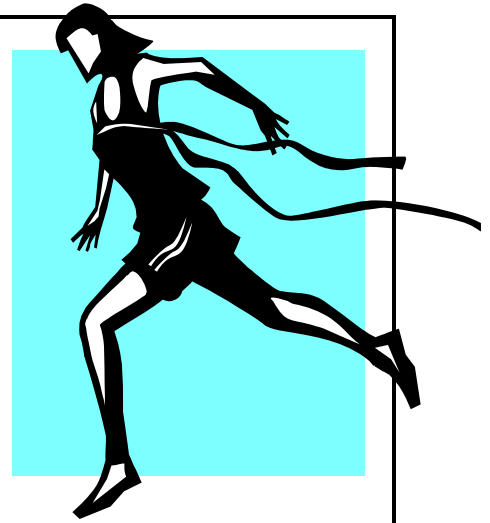

The 2011 Track and Field Season was a success in many ways. The team won at UC, it was 2nd at Elder and Milford and nabbed a 3RD place finish at GGCL for the Varsity team. The JV competed in many Varsity meets this year and performed well with placing 2nd at LaSalle against other GGCL Schools. Most of the girls achieved lifetime PR's in one or several events. There was also a willingness by everyone to do what it took to make the team better. Many of the girls competed in events for the first time including seniors, Abby Wilkymacky, Jenna Moeller, Nora Elson and Kate Gormley who were all rookies in the Field Events. They demonstrated leadership and confidence by competing well. This year has been challenging yet a rewarding year. We look to have many girls competing at Regionals and then on to State. The team are GGCL Champs, and District Runners Up. The 4 x 800 Relay Team placed 4th in the Regionals and 9th at State.



Softball

The **Varsity** Softball team went 7-13 regular season, placing fifth in the GGCL. Unfortunately, they dropped several games by one run that could have easily gone the other way. The girls made some improvements over the season and hope to continue to build on that in the 2012 season. They had three league all stars this season: Junior pitcher Katie Hulsman and Junior Catcher Hannah Raulston received 1st team GGCL all-league; and senior outfielder Rachel Von Luehrte received 2nd team GGCL all-league. They also had two players named to the All-Metro Team, Senior 1st baseman Ashley Bosse named to the 2nd team and Junior Pitcher Katie Hulsman named to the 1st team. Seniors Ashley Bosse and Rachel Von Luehrte played in the Southwest District All-Star game on June 8th.

Overall the **Junior Varsity** team had a rough year with wins and losses, but the players continued to keep their spirits up through each game. Whether they were winning or losing, they continued to practice good sportsmanship. The team bonded well together and always seemed excited to play the game and had a positive attitude. They worked hard during their practices and did continue to learn throughout the season. This is a team with limited experience that will improve with hard work and discipline the more they get to play. They are all very coachable and their coaches appreciate their efforts on the field and off!

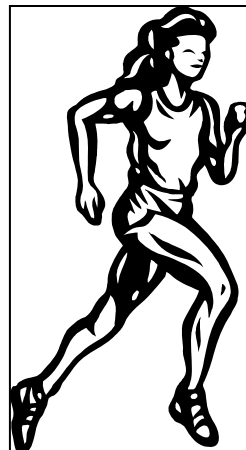
