1. Print the names of the 13 original colonies and Louisiana.
2. The 13 colonies are usually divided into 3 groups: New England, Middle and Southern. Print the names of the 3 groups, outline and shade in the area they encompass on the map.
3. Use the letters LC to label the Jamestown settlement, P1 to label the Pilgrim settlement (Plymouth), P2 to label the Puritan settlement (Boston), and DWI to label the Dutch settlement (New York City).
4. Label the following bodies of water: St. Lawrence River, Atlantic Ocean, Gulf of Mexico, 5 Great Lakes, Ohio and Mississippi Rivers.
5. Use a caret ^^^ to mark the Appalachian Mountains.
6. Draw the 1763 Proclamation Line.
7. Shade with the color of your choice: Spanish Territory, British Territory.
8. Label the following major battles of the French and Indian War and indicate whether or not it is a British victory (B) or a French victory (F).
  - a) Fort Necessity
  - b) Fort Duquesne
  - c) Quebec
  - d) Montreal
9. Make a key (legend) for your map.

Point values vary for maps depending on the number of items to be identified. Assessments include completeness, accuracy, neatness and spelling.
