## Our Mission

### **Block Schedule**

Saint Ursula Academy runs a four-bell collegiate schedule. Students have four 80-minute classes daily. One credit courses are completed in one semester, and half credit courses are completed in half a semester with the exception of some AP courses, which are one and a half semesters.

### **Educational Services Program**

Approximately 15% of the students at Saint Ursula Academy participate in the Educational Services Program for students with learning disabilities and ADHD where they are completely mainstreamed within the collegepreparatory, Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) curriculum. All students in the ES Program benefit from an Academic Tutoring bell during their school day. Students are awarded a .25 credit each semester for successfully completing their Academic Tutoring requirements.

### Instructional Levels Offered

College-Preparatory, Honors, Advanced Placement (AP), and College Credit Plus (C.C.P.) College Credit Plus allows Ohio high school students the ability to take college courses for both high school and college credit.

### **AP Courses**

Enrollment in these classes is competitive and limited. Students are approved for AP courses based on performance in previous prerequisite courses and according to standards set by each department. All students who enroll in AP courses are required to take AP exams.
